5 次の英文を読んで、下の問いに答えなさい。

Do you think that it is bad luck to walk under a ladder or break a mirror? Do you think that black cats and the number 13 are unlucky? There are some people (A) don't believe superstitions, but there are (1) than one million superstitions, and most people believe at (2) one or two of them.

Many people believe superstitions about numbers. They think that there are lucky numbers and unlucky numbers. They often think the number 13 is unlucky. In so many parts of the world, buildings have no ( $\mathcal{T}$ ) floor and streets have no houses with the number 13. In Japan, many people believe that four is unlucky because in Japanese the word "four" sounds just like the word "death." So you will find Room ( $\mathcal{T}$ ) next to Room103 in some hotels.

What are the lucky numbers? Seven is a lucky number in many places, and eight is a lucky number in Japan and China. When the Toyoda family of Japan wanted to form a company, (a) they named their company "Toyota", not "Toyoda". In kana letters "Toyoda" takes ten strokes of pen to write and ten is not a lucky number. But "Toyota" takes eight strokes and eight is a lucky number.

There are many other superstitions, too. There are superstitions about eating, sleeping, animals, holidays, etc. There are even superstitions about superstitions!

Some superstitions have (b) long with, that, have, they, so, been, us] become customs. For ( ③ ), in some parts of the world people often say "God bless you!" when someone sneezes. A long time ago people thought that the soul could fly out of their body during a sneeze. So people ( B ) God to send the soul back into the body. Today we no longer believe that people ( A ) sneeze will lose their souls, but we still say "God bless you!" We say it because we think it is polite for us to say (c) so.
